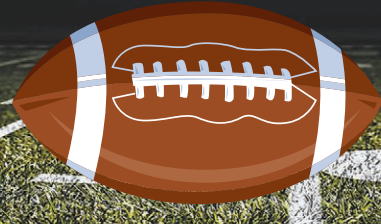

Ole Miss football duo earns SEC weekly accolades

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. — Two Rebels collected weekly honors from the Southeastern Conference after a 59-42 win over South Carolina, the league office announced Monday.

Quarterback Matt Corral earned SEC Co-Offensive Player of the Week honors, while sophomore tackle Nick Brooker collected SEC Co-Offensive Lineman of the Week accolades.

Corral broke the Ole Miss single-game passing record with 513 yards in leading the Rebels past

the Gamecocks. He completed 28 of 32 passes for 513 yards and four touchdowns, while rushing for another score.

His 533 total yards are the second most in school history, behind Archie Manning's 540 total yards in 1969. It marked Corral's fifth 300-yard passing game of the season, tied for third-best in school history. The Ventura, California, native moved into a tie for fifth on Ole Miss' single-season record list with 22 passing TDs and tied for ninth on the Rebel career charts with 30 scoring passes.

Brooker, who has started ever game this season at left tackled for the Rebels, paved the way for

an historic 708 total yards of offense on Saturday night. It marked the third most offensive yards in school history and the most ever in an SEC contest.

The Springfield, Illinois, native played every offensive snap and protected Corral during his historic night. The Rebel offense also rushed for 195 yards and four touchdowns.

OXFORD, Miss. — The Ole Miss at Texas A&M football game, originally scheduled for Nov. 21, has been postponed due to the continued quarantine of

individuals within the Texas A&M football program, consistent with Southeastern Conference COVID-19 management requirements.

Because Texas A&M has a game tentatively scheduled for December 12, the opportunity to reschedule

the Ole Miss at Texas A&M game will be evaluated. The rescheduling of games on the remaining SEC football schedule will include December 19 as a playing date. The SEC's COVID-19 management requirements, as developed by the SEC's

Pearl River's Noah Mitchell named Forrest General Wildcat of the Week

POPLARVILLE, Miss. — Pearl River standout linebacker Noah Mitchell (Leakesville; Greene County) has been named the Forrest General Wildcat of the Week following his standout performance at Hinds last Thursday. This is the second time this season Mitchell has

received the honor.

The honor comes on the heels of another monster performance by Mitchell. In PRCC's 34-14 defeat at Hinds last week, Mitchell was all over the field. Not only did the sophomore record 15 tackles, he also returned a fumble 10 yards for a touchdown. The score was Mitchell's second time to find pay dirt in 2020 after returning an interception for a

TD at Copiah-Lincoln in PRCC's second game of the season.

Mitchell finished Year 2 at The River similarly to how he concluded his freshman campaign — atop the national leaderboards. Mitchell's 13.8 tackles-per-games are tops in the Mississippi Association of Community Colleges Conference — the only JUCO league to play football this fall. His 83 tackles are

25 more than the next defender. Mitchell also finished the year with 2.5 sacks, 9 tackles-for-loss and two interceptions — all tops on PRCC.

In addition to Mitchell, Jakob Greer (Bay St. Louis; St. Stanislaus) has also won the award twice. Other recipients this season have been Tavion Smith (Hattiesburg; Oak Grove) and Jairus McFarland (Hattiesburg).

Poplarville shuts down South Pike in second round

The Poplarville Hornets employed a strong defensive performance last week to beat South Pike 27-6.
